CITY OF LAFAYETTE Lafayette Youth Advisory Committee Meeting April 19, 2017

Call to Order/Roll Call

Co-Chair Megan Schmid called the April 19, 2017 meeting to order at 6:35 p.m. at the Bob L. Burger Recreation Center, 111 W. Baseline Road, Lafayette, Colorado. Co-Chair Megan Schmid reintroduced Boulder County Public Health (BCPH) Healthy Beverage & Food Advisor Tessa Hale, inviting her to conduct a brief coalition survey and provide updates pertaining to the Committee's *BoCo for H2O* and *Lafayette's Choice* campaigns.

Co-Chair Ignacio Perez and Project Advisor Katherine Dishman invited members to consider content for the Committee's new Facebook page. They also reviewed deliverables associated with the Committee's *Lafayette's Choice* campaign.

Megan Schmid invited the Committee to reflect on previous community events, including BCPH's Shake Off Sugar, which held on April 15, and the City's annual Cesar Chavez Convivio, which the Committee hosted on April 8. Members particularly considered strategies to engage more youth in future events as well as opportunities to promote community initiatives.

Co-Chair Eden Piller reviewed the agenda for Lafayette in Action, which the Empowerment Center of East County will host on April 22 in conjunction with Global Youth Service Day. Members will specifically support a trail restoration project in the morning in collaboration with Open Space, Thorne Nature Experience, and Wildlands Restoration Volunteers and celebrate their collective contributions and continued service to the community in the afternoon. The event will run from 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Co-Chair Abraheem Abu-Shanab noted that new member applications would be available on May 3. Completed applications are due July 19; member interviews will be held in August. Six seats will be available, beginning August 2017.
