
Attendance Policies



What is Writing Buddies?

Writing Buddies is: a

free program where trained teen volunteers lead younger kids through a series of creative writing activities, including brainstorming, revising, and editing.

Writing Buddies is designed to encourage your child to explore a variety of genres under the guidance of a teen mentor who loves to write.

Writing Buddies is

NOT: a tutoring service for your child. The volunteers are not qualified or expected to teach your child to write scholastic essays.

Who can participate?

- Students who will be in grades 4-6 in the fall are eligible.
- Students must be able to attend all—or almost all—of the meetings.
- We prefer that the participants genuinely enjoy writing or at least are open to the idea of taking a summer writing class. If your child is not at all interested in this program, please don't force him or her to attend; rather, let us offer that space to another child who truly wants to be here.

More about Writing Buddies

Who are the Big

Buddies? Experienced high school and college Big Buddies will serve as the Writing Big Buddies. These volunteers love reading and writing, enjoy working with younger children, and want to give back to their community. They receive training before and during the program.



How is it structured?

- Each day, the Big Buddies will lead the class through one or two creative writing activities.
- The Big Buddies will work in small groups with the same Writing Buddies each meeting. They will do brainstorming, prewriting, and editing together.
- On the last day, the Buddies will present one of their favorite original pieces. They will also receive a booklet with each other's writings and a free book.

I'd like my child to be a Writing Buddy. What do I need to do?

- Submit the application to have your child matched with a Reading Buddy no later than **Friday. May 25.**Space is limited, so we strongly encourage you to apply early. Priority is given to Lafayette residents and children who attend Lafayette schools.
- Applications are available in the library in English and Spanish and online in English at www.cityoflafayette.com.
- The program will take place on Thursday afternoons, 4:00-5:00 pm, from June 7 through August 2.
