

If you are a victim of a crime that occurred on the internet the Lafayette Police Department needs you to make a report with one of the following federal agencies, before a police report can be taken.

If your crime has the following criteria:

- COUNTERFEIT CHECK SCAM-CRAIGSLIST, MONEY ORDER, OR OTHER INTERNET SCAMS
- DATA BREACH
   – PERSONAL
   INFORMATION THAT WAS
   DISCLOSED DUE TO THE BREACH
   OF A COMPANY'S DATA
- TELEMARKETING SCAMS OR COMPLAINTS
- EMAIL SPAM COMPLAINTS
- DEBT COLLECTION COMPLAINTS
- CREDIT REPORTING COMPLAINTS

If your crime has the following criteria:

- ID THEFT OR POTENTIAL ID THEFT- INCLUDING UNAUTHORIZED USE OF CREDIT CARDS THROUGH THE INTERNET
- SPAM (UNSOLICITED COMMERCIAL EMAIL)
- SCAM EMAILS PRETENDING TO COME FROM THE FBI
- MONEY OR SHOPPING SCAMS
- COMPUTER HACKING
- COPYRIGHT
