NeW! **Leaving on a Trip:** All trips leave from the parking lot of the Senior Center at 103 S. Iowa Ave. Please plan to meet the bus or van there.

While on a Trip, please depart at the scheduled time: plan to board the bus 15 minutes before the scheduled departure time. Due to scheduling, the bus needs to leave on time. If you return more than 15 minutes late, you will miss the bus! You will then be responsible for paying for your own transportation back to Lafayette.
