Borrowing Materials Check out materials at the front desk or at the Express Check Out in the lobby. The check out period for most items is three weeks. Your receipt will list the items and their due dates and you may also check your account online from home at any time.

Email reminders Sign up for email and receive reminders several days before items are due. You will also receive hold notices and over-due notices by email. We will not share or sell your information with any other entity. You will receive periodic email communications from the library, including Books & Bytes, our monthly newsletter.



Renewing You may renew most materials once if the item is not on hold for someone else. You can renew online, at any library computer, or by calling the Check Out Desk.

Reserving Materials Use your library card to put an item on hold online, at any library computer, or by calling the Reference Desk. If you do not find the materials you want, we may be able to borrow it from other sources. There is a \$1.00 charge for failing to pick up a reserved item without first notifying the library.

Late, Lost, and Damaged Items Unless noted otherwise, late fees are 25¢ per item per day late. There is a replacement charge for lost or damaged items. We do not accept a duplicate item as a replacement. If you owe the library more than \$5.00, you will lose library card privileges and all accounts owing \$25.00 or more will be sent to a collection agency for an additional \$10.00.

Book Return You may return most materials in the book return box just inside the lobby, or in the 24 hour drive-up book return outside.

Confidentiality The library respects the privacy of all our customers. Unless required by law, library staff will not divulge account information to anyone.

Colorado Libraries Collaborate You may check out materials at no extra cost, from many other Colorado libraries. You will need to have your hometown library card to register at each library.

Study Rooms Use your library card to reserve our study rooms for quiet study. Ask at the Reference Desk.

Meeting Rooms Go online for details about library meeting rooms, which are available to the public.

Computers Use your library card to log on to any of our computers to check your email, use the Internet, or work on personal projects. Please pre-pay for printing at the check out desk, 10¢ per page.

Copies Make black and white copies for 10¢ per page.

Children and Choices Please help your children make decisions about library resources, the Internet, and the materials they borrow from the library.

Provide Answers to Questions Librarians will provide comprehensive answers to your questions. Whether for school or business research, call, ask at the Reference Desk, or ask online.
