

# RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS CITY OF LAFAYETTE

## PUBLIC ART COMMITTEE October 9, 2019

The October 9, 2019, Public Art Committee Meeting began at 7:00 p.m. at The Collective, 201 North Public Road, Lafayette, Colorado.

### **Call to Order**

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

Those in attendance were Heidi Mallon (LCAC Liaison), Bea Glassford (Treasurer), Lindsey Wohlman, Josie Knapp, Heather Bair, Lisa Michot, and Stacey Bernstein (City Public Art Coordinator).

Visitors were Adrianna Hance and Tara Szwejcer, students at the University of Colorado who are shadowing J.D. Mangat. Also in attendance were Nicole Samson, member of City Council, and Matthew Doubek, a local artist invited to help select the Jean Mellblom Award winner.

Barbara Rudlaff (Chair), Pamela Sherrick (Secretary), Susan Booker (ACRD Director/City Staff Liaison), J.D. Mangat (City Council Liaison) were absent.

### **Approval of Minutes**

Bea Glassford made a motion that was seconded by Josie Knapp **to approve the minutes of the September 11, 2019, meeting** . The motion passed unanimously.

### **Vice Chair Election**

Heidi Mallon **nominated Lindsey Wohlman to replace Tara Gale as Vice Chair of PAC** . This was seconded by Bea Glassford. The motion passed unanimously.

### **Reappoint Barbara & Heather to Public Arts Committee**

Barbara Rudlaff's and Heather Bair's positions on PAC were up for re-election. Bea Glassford **nominated Barbara Rudlaff and Heather Bair to be re-elected to their positions.** Josie Knapp seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

### **Jean Mellblom Award**

Matthew Doubek and PAC members discussed how to best approach giving out this award as the value has been increased. Conversation was extensive, everyone discussed their varied perspectives on the merits of a number of AOTS sculptures before a rough tally was made. The piece with the most votes was "Nature in Balance... the Vulture" by Christopher "Shark" Lambdin.

### **Art Night Out Debrief**

Stacey reports that September's ANO was the biggest event of the season. Rachel Hansen is already working on arranging bands for the 2020 season.

### **Art on the Street: See & Respond!**

Stacey reported that the See & Respond event has over 100 submissions. Appreciation was given to Bea Glassford and Lisa Michot for their help framing and hanging the exhibit. Stacey is still looking for some day-of volunteers. Many AOTS artists have confirmed they will be there.

### **Art on the Street: 2020**

Stacey reports that the Call for Artists has received 20 entries so far. There will be several additional rounds of advertising and promotion as the deadline approaches.

#### **Matthew Hoffman 287 Project**

Stacey reports that there is no update on the project. There will be a planning meeting with Public Works and other departments later this month.

#### **Update locations for purchased sculptures**

Stacey reports that several locations have been finalized. The rock for “Swan Lake it isn’t” has been purchased. Both “Catfish” and “Iguana” have no progress due to various challenges with building owners and installation questions that need to be resolved.

#### **PAC Grant Timeline**

Stacey shared a draft of a timeline for the process of the grant from call to completion. Next steps include finalizing and deciding on how many recipients will be considered for the grant.

#### **Recruiting**

Stacey reports recruiting is continuing and encourages all members to reach out to anyone they think might want to volunteer to serve on the PAC board.

#### **Budget Report**

Stacey reports there are no changes to the budget.

#### **Report from LCAC**

Heidi reports that LCAC is continuing its work on guiding documents. They are reviewing Arts in Community grant applications (26 were received) and they should have finalists determined at the next meeting.

#### **City Council Liaison Report**

There is no report as J.D. was not present.

#### **Adjourn**

Heather Bair made a motion, seconded by Josie Knapp, **that the meeting be adjourned at 8:02 pm.** The motion passed unanimously.
