

# RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS CITY OF LAFAYETTE

## PUBLIC ART COMMITTEE November 13, 2019

The November 13, 2019, Public Art Committee Meeting began at 6:00 p.m. at The Collective, 201 North Public Road, Lafayette, Colorado.

### Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Barbara Rudlaff, Chair, at 6:08 pm.

Those in attendance were Barbara Rudlaff (Chair), Lindsey Wohlman (Vice Chair), Bea Glassford (Treasurer), Pamela Sherrick (Secretary), Heather Bair, Josie Knapp, Lisa Michot, J.D. Mangat (City Council Liaison), Susan Booker (ACRD Director/City Staff Liaison), and Stacey Bernstein (City Public Art Coordinator).

Heidi Mallon (LCAC Liaison) was absent.

Andrew DeBakker, a local Lafayette real estate agent, was a visitor for part of the PAC meeting.

### Approval of Minutes

Pamela Sherrick made a motion that was seconded by Barbara Rudlaff **to approve the minutes of the October 9, 2019, meeting** . The motion passed unanimously.

### Authorize See & Respond AOTS Winners

Barbara Rudlaff made a motion that was seconded by Bea Glassford to award the \$1,000.00 **Jean Mellblom Award for 2019** to Christopher “Shark” Lambdin for his sculpture **Nature in Balance.. The Vulture** . The motion passed unanimously. The Jean Mellblom award winner was selected at the October 9, 2019, PAC meeting by PAC members and invited local artist Matthew Doubek.

Barbara Rudlaff also made a motion that was seconded by Lindsey Wohlman to award the \$500.00 **People’s Choice Award for 2019** to Susan Jochum for her sculpture **Night Sentry** . The motion passed unanimously. Attendees at the Meet the Artists, See & Respond reception were all invited to vote for the People’s Choice award.

Barbara Rudlaff made another motion that was seconded by Pamela Sherrick to award the \$500.00 **Most Inspiring Award for 2019** to Joe Forrest Sackett for his sculpture **Form in Red** . The motion passed unanimously. More artists who submitted artwork for the See & Respond event were inspired by Joe’s sculpture than any other.

### Debrief Meet the Artists, See & Respond Reception

Stacey Bernstein complimented PAC members and thanked them for volunteering at the Meet the Artists, See & Respond reception held in October. She remarked that the event was very well attended, well planned, and enjoyed by all who attended. She commented on the positive response in both participation and attendance by community members of all ages. Several PAC members concurred with her assessment of the event.

### Final Budget Report

Susan Booker provided the Committee with a final updated budget for 2019. Actual expenses for the year were \$60,187, leaving a balance of \$37,813 that will carry over into 2020. PAC members agreed to discuss at the January 2020 meeting possible acquisitions from the 2019

AOTS program for the City of Lafayette permanent art collection or reserving funds for a future large project.

**Select 2020 AOTS Finalists**

Stacey Bernstein provided PAC members with a printed list of the 137 submissions for the 2020 Art on the Street program. The list included thumbnail photographs, titles of the artwork, dimensions, and materials used in construction. The Committee then proceeded to view a slide show of all submissions for the 2020 AOTS program several times. Pros and cons, likes and dislikes, construction, and size of the submitted works were discussed with great enthusiasm and good humor. From the 137 works submitted, the Committee finally selected 26 sculptures (including alternates) for the 2020 AOTS program. From these selections, the Committee hopes to have a final count of 19-21 pieces in Art on the Street 2020. Stacey Bernstein will begin the process of notifying the artists whose work was selected, and those whose work was not selected. A meeting to share PAC's selections with Public Works and Risk Management is scheduled for November 22, 2019.
